Monte Tavor is very proud of how our preschool curriculum has developed over the years. This past spring and summer children had a fantastic time filled with endless activities, events, and exciting mementos. Children spent 80-90% of their time outdoors. They were able to participate in outdoor activities in at least two to three facilities each day and each week. You can read about these activities in each of our newsletters in the "Infant," "Toddler," and "Preschool" groups. Now, as we say goodbye to our memorable summer, graduates and a few families, we would also like to welcome and say "Bienvenidos" to all our new students and their families.

Monte Tavor have been diligently working to put together new tools and information for families. Beginning with Kinderloop; an online app designed for childcares and preschools as a communication tool for families to privately share a child's development and progress. We will be able to upload photos and short clips of activities throughout the week. All that is required is a consent form to begin engaging families in their child's activities. SmartCare is another tool to stay connected with your child. This new app will allow parents to sign in/ sign out their children through their smart phones or a kiosk found at the entrance, enabling parents to keep tracks of their hours through an efficient signing in and out experience. A journaling feature will allow photos and videos to be received by parents of their individual child as they occur. Parents will now be able to pay their child's tuition with a credit card or debited from a checking account. The online web portal will give all parents access through log-in to their individual information at any time they choose. We are hoping to launch by the end of October. More information will be obtained through conferences held on site by a SmartCare team member. Dates will be posted soon.

Emergency Protocols

Emergency and Safety Preparedness is revised every year around August and September. We are implementing a suggestion from last year; that on a yearly basis each child is to bring their own backpack with their own supplies and medication needed in the event of an emergency. At the end of each year, expiration dates will be inspected and any goods perishable within six months will be donated to the Alameda County Food Bank. A list of suggested foods will be emailed to each family. A family recently reached out to us and suggested that Monte Tavor prepare a written emergency plan to be distributed to families. Our current written emergency plan and protocol sent last year to families is being revised and will be expanded upon. A copy will be presented and distributed to each family within the next week.

Staying Connected

Monte Tavor hopes all these new tools and information will be of great benefit in further involving school life with parents. Monte Tavor believes we can connect children with parents even while they are at work, so they do not miss precious moments in their child's growth at school. Summer/Fall 2015

Infants

Young Infants usually start our programs in the fall or early spring. We are currently putting together the fall young infant group (3-6 months). Young infants as they become mobile infants are stepped up to the next facility to participate in more hands on activities in fall or spring.

Mobile infants (8-14 months) are spending their outdoor time crawling, cruising non-stop, and learning to walk. They have been participating in music, singing, reading books, playing with soft blocks, mirrored balls, dolls, and stuffed animals. They use non-battery operated swings, xylophones, pop-up and musical boxes, shakers and drums. Each day they look forward to the outdoor play areas. As mobile infants are playing with one another they are noticing more and more what others are playing with as they are grabbing toys from each other.

Older infants (15-23 months) continue to be challenged during their rapid growth. By this fall/early winter older infants will be turning two years of age and officially becoming toddlers. The activities presented to this group are: water play which include bubbles, corn starch, flour, and themed toy animal props for pouring and measuring activities. Art activities using washable paints, water colors, and flour play dough.
